We cannot be responsible for forgotten boxes. ***Unclaimed boxes that remain at the pickup point beyond noon of the Friday following delivery will be donated to a local food pantry or other recipient.***

Dripping Springs Garden CSA Subscriber-Grower Agreement 2018

Subscribers will receive a box of produce each week for a 23-week season, beginning May 17 and ending October 18. The assortment of produce will vary throughout the season and contain a wide variety, ranging from lettuce to tomatoes, parsley to peppers, basil to green beans (see CSA harvest schedule). Due to the unpredictability of farming, we cannot guarantee any specific item. We do not customize individual boxes.

For the 2018 season, subscribers may purchase a regular share for \$600 or a small share for \$440. A subscriber may elect to pay the full amount at registration, or make a deposit of \$200 to hold their place, with the balance due in full by April 15. For those for whom the full balance deadline is a hardship, please call us to arrange split payments.

A Cut Flower Share may be purchased for \$230. Subscribers will receive a fresh, \$10.00 bouquet of flowers each week for 23 weeks from May 17 through October 18.

Subscribers are responsible for picking up their boxes at the designated pickup point-- 344 S. Combs Ave. (home of shareholder Joy Fox) in Fayetteville, on Thursday mornings. Shareholders are encouraged to find friends or family to pick up their share if they will be away or cannot pick up in the morning (please don't let your share wilt in the afternoon heat!). **Once per season**, subscribers may obtain a food credit for **one week's share** if they will be away and are unable to find a substitute. Credit may be redeemed at a later date. **A one-week notice is required to either cancel delivery or redeem the credit.** Share boxes are returned each week to pick-up location for re-use.

Our shareholders are welcome to arrange to visit the farm anytime during the growing season (aware that we must continue the work on regular work-days), and we will host at least one shareholder-only farm tour during the summer. Since we are about an hour from Fayetteville, helping out on the farm is not possible for many folks, but if you'd like to come and work with us, let us know!
